Methodology: The sample size for the survey is 476 registered voters nation-wide taken from a listed sample. 377 interviews were collected using automated telephone technology and 99 were collected using mobile web interviews. The margin of error is +/- 4.49%. Interviews were conducted January 14-15, 2018 by TPC Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
