As expected, 2018 was a challenging midterm election cycle, but thanks to your contribution, America First Action is proud to report that we had a <u>winning record</u> and helped elect and re-elect exceptional individuals who will support the agenda of the Trump-Pence Administration.

Historically, the party of the President suffers a loss of U.S. House and Senate seats in their first midterm election. Because of your support, we were able to defy pundits' projections that Republicans would lose over $60^{1,2}$ seats and potentially the Senate³ in 2018. In the post-World War II period, the President's party has lost seats in the House and gained seats in the Senate <u>only three times</u> – 1962, 1970, and 1982.

Furthermore, Democrats in the House and Senate benefitted from a "Green Wave" of financial support at all levels. Democrat House campaigns raised the most money in American history and, as noted in the *Wall Street Journal*, "Former New York City Mayor Michael Bloomberg's Independence USA super PAC is spending more on television advertising in the campaign's final week than all of the GOP candidates in the 82 most competitive races combined."
